

Japan May Give Half of KR Tribunal Funds

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Japan may contribute up to half of the \$56 million needed for a UN backed Khmer Rouge tribunal, Sean Visoth, secretary of the government's tribunal task force, said Sunday. Ikeda Hirotsugu, first secretary of the Japanese Embassy in Phnom Penh, would not reveal an exact amount but said Sunday that the Japanese government is planning to contribute "a lot of money and human resources. The Japanese Diet is discussing how much will be contribute, he added.
