

UN Delegate to KR Trial Arrives in Cambodia

Michelle Lee, the UN's representative to the Khmer Rouge tribunal, arrived in Cambodia on Saturday to take up residence in preparation for the long-awaited trials, a government official said. Sean Visoth, the Cambodian government's tribunal coordinator, confirmed Lee's arrival. A formal meeting between the UN delegation head and Sean Visoth may take place today, he said. "I have not met with her yet. Maybe we will meet with her tomorrow," Sean Visoth said on Sunday, adding that he had been busy over the weekend overseeing the installation of air-conditioning equipment at the RCAF headquarters in Kandal province's Ang Snuol district, which will be used for the tribunal proceedings.
