SWEDEN: BOSNIAN EX-LEADER TO SERVE SENTENCE Biljana Plavsic, the former president of Bosnia who was sentenced in February to 11 years in prison and expressed remorse for her role in the 1992-95 ethnic war, was transferred from The Hague to Sweden to serve her prison time. Mrs. Plavsic, 72, was being held in a Stockholm jail, said the deputy director of the Swedish Prison Service, Doris Hogue. "She has arrived and we will decide soon, after processing her, which prison she will go to," she said. She added that Mrs. Plavsic, the most senior politician to be sentenced by the international war crimes tribunal, would probably be transferred to the Hinseberg women's prison, 110 miles west of Stockholm. The prison has color television in its cells, a sauna and a massage room.(Reuters)
