ZVORNIK, 3 Oct (Onasa) -- A total of 212 incomplete and one complete skeletons have been exhumed so far from the secondary mass grave in Liplje near Zvornik, Head of the Tuzla team of the BiH Federation Commission for Missing Persons Murat Hurtic said on Monday [3 October].

Hurtic said that remains are transported the Commemoration Centre in Tuzla for identification.

He said that the grave probably contains remains of Bosniak victims from Srebrenica.

The exhumation process began on 15 September.
