THE HAGUE: PRISON CAMP COMMANDER EXTRADITED Zeljko Meakic, the Bosnian Serb commander of the notorious Omarska prison camp in the 1990's ethnic war, was handed over to the war crimes tribunal, ending an eight-year run as one of its most-wanted fugitives. Mr. Meakic, 38, will be brought before a judge next week on five counts of war crimes and crimes against humanity, including murder and torture. Omarska was one of three camps in the Prijedor region of Bosnia that prosecutors compared with Nazi death camps. (AP)
