

No Arrest for Ex-President of Mexico

A federal judge refused to issue an arrest warrant against former President Luis Echeverría in connection with a massacre of student protesters in 1968.

On Monday, a prosecutor filed charges of genocide against Mr. Echeverría for the massacre, in which soldiers fired on student protesters, killing dozens, but the judge said there was insufficient evidence for the charge.

Mr. Echeverría, now 83, was interior minister in 1968, and president from 1970 to 1976. In July, another judge ruled that Mr. Echeverría could not be charged in the killings of two dozen protesters in 1971.
